U3A stands for University of the Third Age. It is an organisation for older people no longer in full time employment who are interested in pursuing a variety of learning and recreational activities.

U3A promotes a range of learning opportunities and a focused and positive image of ageing. U3A meeting formats are more informal than regular classrooms and – there are no exams!

Any retiree can join:

There are no educational pre-requisites. Costs are kept low as tutors and group leaders come from within the groups.

The annual subscription is \$30 per person (\$45 if the newsletter posted), with low incidental costs for some groups.

U3A members organise their own activities, share their knowledge and skills on a voluntary basis and have fun together.
