Introduction	<p>Are you wondering where to start with your Family Tree?</p> <p>Have you started your tree but would like to further develop your skills using online family history resources?</p> <p>This could be the course for you!</p> <p>It is a very hands-on course that requires basic computer skills and access to a laptop or computer.</p> <p>The course includes two sessions a month.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A group session each month, where we focus on presenting online family history resources that will be helpful in your research. The presentations will include resources such as Ancestry.com; Trove; My Heritage; Scotland's People and other online records such as Births/Deaths/Marriages, PROV, State Library, Rates Notices and Cemetery Records. 2. A one-to-one mentoring session each month, which will focus on your specific needs as you research and develop your Family Tree.

Most class members move on to maintain, or regularly renew for 'working periods', a subscription with at least one online genealogy site such as ancestry.com.au or myheritage.com. Subscriptions are available monthly, six monthly, or yearly.</p>
