A one-to-one mentoring session each month, which will focus on your specific needs as you research and develop your Family Tree.

Most class members move on to maintain, or regularly renew for 'working periods', a subscription with at least one online genealogy site such as ancestry.com.au or myheritage.com. Subscriptions are available monthly, six monthly, or yearly.
