

Workshop process

STEP 1:

Story read aloud for each one to follow

STEP 2:

Round table comments

- Overall positive view
 - What kept you engaged?
 - What will you remember about the story?

STEP 3:

More specific comments

- Did the start grab you? Why/why not? For example:
 - Did you have an immediate picture of the location and/or main character/s
 - Did it take too long to introduce the story/main character/s?
 - How were the characters defined? Through action? Through dialogue?
 - Was the introduction to the characters too passive or bland?
- Did the end round off the story? How? For example:
 - Were the issues resolved?
 - Did you feel that there was something more needed?
- Did the story flow? For example:
 - Is it well paced?
 - Is it cluttered?
 - Is it repetitive?
 - Is there superfluous information?
 - Is it too complicated?
- Did it flow grammatically? For example:
 - Are the sentences too wordy? Monotonous?
 - Is there use of clichés; or are they over done?
 - Is punctuation used correctly? Does it matter?
